In Fishkill, Dutchess Co NY, wrote her will in Jan., 1863, "being driven by the Civil War from my home in Virginia." Named daughters Margaret Ann (Mrs. Cornelius Cooper) and Martha (Mrs. Edward Ladue). Widow of Stephen Ferguson. Wills A2:21

LOUISA FERGUSON

Registered in Nov., 1831 as a free black. Then about 20 years old, 5'6", scar on the nose between her eyes, also a scar on the back of the right hand. Pleasant countenance. Daughter of

Delia, a free woman. Registered again in Oct., 1834, where her mother's name was given as Celia. Registered in 1839 and 1852. In the later descriptions her height was given as 5'6½" and the scar was located on the left hand.

Her daughter, Adaline Gray, registered in Sept., 1852. She was a mulatto, age 21. Ibid.:403

William and Louisa Ferguson filed claim in 1873 for wartime damage. She was then 69 and living near Accotink. From 1861 to 1867 she rented a farm 5 miles from Alexandria on the Mount Vernon Road from Mrs. Moore. Worked at the market in Alexandria; also worked at the Union hospital at Col. Kemper's place doing laundry. Is married. Her father was Gen. Washington's carpenter. After being emancipated, he purchased her mother before Louisa was born. Her husband was a slave of Dennis Johnston.
