This deed made this fifteenth day of October Eighteen hundred and sixty nine between Black R. Canfield and Harriet Canfield his wife of the first part and E. C. Bond, E. C. Eckley, Geo. W. Williams, G. P. Spier, W. C. Chapman, Charles H. Carver and J. E. Richardson trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church South of the second part, all of the County of Fairfax and State of Virginia, Witnesses, that in consideration of the sum of Fifty dollars, the said parties of the first part do grant, bargain and sell with general warranty, unto the said second parties, the following described lot a parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County and State, being a part of the farm on which said first parties at present reside and bounded as follows Beginning on Ellygo Church Road at the corner of the old Church lot and running with the line of said lot back Fifty nine feet, thence by a line parallel with said road and at right angles with said line Forty feet, thence parallel with the line of said Church lot to said road, thence with said road to the beginning containing in sum. The Trusts nevertheless for the use and benefit of the said M. E. Church South, to erect thereon a house of public worship for the use of the congregation of said Church and the Ministers thereof, who shall from time to time be appointed by the conference of the said M. E. Church South to officiate in

worship therein and for no other purpose. And the said parties of the second part trustees as aforesaid in order to promote the purpose of this conveyance for themselves and their successors in office do accept the same with the conditions and limitations herein expressed Witness the following signatures and seals
